Combining beautiful curves, the AGMA logo is skillfully wrapped around corners, in homage to Dali's famous "Persistence of Time" from 1931 with its bent clocks. Created by a master carver at Seattle Solstice, and marking the 2011 AGMA/ABMA Annual Meeting, this item is also a true objet d'art to be treasured in any millennium. The winning bid will be designated to the Don McVittie Memorial Educational Fund to provide graduate-level academic scholarships.

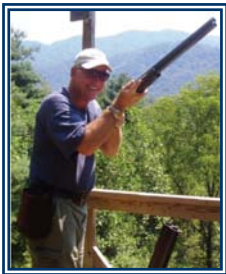
