



## Visitors guide to the Komatsu South Harbor Milwaukee campus

### Getting to the South Harbor campus

#### Airports



#### ▶ General Mitchell International Airport (MKE)

About 15 minutes from the South Harbor campus and about 20 minutes from downtown hotels

#### ▶ Chicago O'Hare (ORD)

About 75 miles from the South Harbor campus, or about an hour and 15 minutes depending on traffic. About 78 miles from downtown hotels

#### Driving directions



#### ▶ From the North (I-43)

- Exit at National Avenue (Exit 311)
- Branch right to Ninth Street, turn right, then right again on National Avenue
- Turn right on First Street (Hwy. 32)
- Turn left on Greenfield Avenue to Harbor District

#### ▶ From the West (I-94E)

- Merge onto I-43 South/I-94 East toward Chicago
- Exit at National Avenue (Exit 311)
- Follow I-43 directions

#### ▶ From the South (I-43 North/I-94 West)

- Exit at Becher Street/Mitchell Street (Exit 312A-312B)
- Stay left on the ramp toward Lapham Boulevard/Greenfield Avenue
- Turn right on Greenfield Avenue to Harbor District

#### When you arrive



- Once you arrive at the truck and shovel monument at our entrance, enter the visitor parking lot
- At the gate, push the intercom button for security to grant you access
- Park in any open space
- Proceed to the main lobby by the welcome sign
- Check in at the reception desk, where your Komatsu contact will be notified
- While on campus, Komatsu requires all visitors to follow all safety protocols, which are outlined elsewhere in this guide



## Safety



At the Komatsu South Harbor campus, safety is our first priority. Please follow these guidelines when visiting the manufacturing facility. (If only attending a meeting, regular office attire is fine.)

- Closed-toe shoes are required
- No shorts, please
- Komatsu will provide safety glasses, vests and hard hats to wear at all times on the manufacturing tour
- Visitors must be 18 years of age to operate machinery

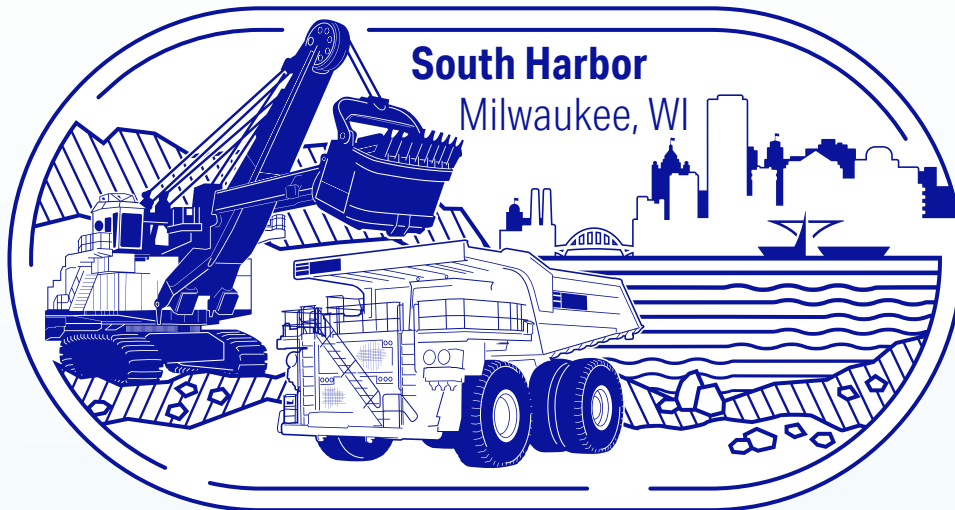
